*** Refers to all of our hikes. There are 6 things you need to know about our hikes. 1) We carry a First Aid kit on each hike and the hike leader is familiar with common hiking injuries. 2) If you have just arrived in Red River, we **STRONGLY RECOMMEND** that you do not come on the hike the day of your arrival. It takes a little bit of time to become acclimated to the altitude here. 3) If you have not been very physically active in the past month, then our hikes might be a bit difficult for you. 4) Young children must be accompanied by an adult or they will not be allowed to come on the hike. 5) We encourage you to wear some kind of hat or head covering during the hike. 6) Please bring **WATER!!!** It's very easy to become dehydrated in Red River and you need lots of water. Thank you for helping us make our hikes a great experience!
